

**RESOLUTION NO. 2-2017**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF TRAPPE TO ADOPT THE 2017 TALBOT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION & COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PLAN AS THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF TRAPPE**

WHEREAS, the Town of Trappe, a Maryland municipal corporation located within the geographical limits of Talbot County, Maryland, recognizes that the Federal Disaster Act of 2000 requires that all states and local jurisdictions develop, submit, and update a hazard mitigation plan that may reduce the impacts of hazards; and

WHEREAS, an adopted hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future federal funding for hazard mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Trappe participated in the planning process along with other municipal corporations located within Talbot County, Maryland, to prepare the 2017 Talbot County Hazard Mitigation & Community Resilience Plan.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Talbot County Department of Emergency Services is authorized to submit on behalf the Town of Trappe, the adopted 2017 TALBOT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION & COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PLAN to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for final review and approval, and application within the Town of Trappe.


